Congratulations! You have almost reached the end of your high school journey and are looking forward to your next exciting steps. The Delta Phi Chapter of Epsilon Sigma Alpha, Intl. is a service organization that values education and we are proud to offer you the opportunity to apply for a \$1,500 scholarship to aid you in your educational endeavors.

The Delta Phi Scholarship application is an online-only process that will be open starting November 15, 2025 through February 28, 2026. All High School seniors who live in Llano County and Burnet County are welcome to apply. All educational opportunities, including 2-year, 4-year and trade schools are eligible.

Basic application information you will need to include:

- Name and contact information
- Academic information
- Future education and career interests
- Family contact information and basic financial information
- Essay – 250-700 words on ONE of the following topics (you will type or copy and paste your answer directly into the online application):
  - Reflect on the personal growth you experienced through community service, including new skills learned and deepened understanding of the community.
  - Reflect on something that someone has done for you that made you happy or thankful in a surprising way. How has this gratitude affected or motivated you?

In addition to the basic application information, here is a list of the documentation you will be asked to upload:

- Copy of up-to-date transcript as of January 2026 (This can be emailed after application is received for those that apply before January)
- Resume
- Two Letters of Recommendation (cannot be family members)
